KHAZEI COMMITS TO OPEN WESTERN MASS REGIONAL OFFICE IF ELECTED TO U.S. SENATE

BOSTON—U.S. Senate candidate and Co-Founder of City Year, Alan Khazei, has announced that if he is elected to the U.S. Senate he will open a regional senate office in Springfield to serve the four western Massachusetts counties.

“This campaign is about empowering citizens and if I am given the privilege to serve as a Senator from Massachusetts I want to bring the same approach to the Senate that I have brought to this campaign. My job will be to make it easier for citizens to reach their government,” said Khazei.

"People living in Berkshire, Franklin, Hampden and Hampshire counties deserve their own local office where constituent casework will be handled and where they can have direct access to me without having to travel across the state," Khazei furthered.

“It is unfair that the citizens of western Mass have to drive across the state to visit their U.S. Senator’s office. Alan’s commitment to opening up a senate office on the western part of the state shows his commitment to all citizens of our Commonwealth,” said campaign Co-Chair, State Representative Smitty Pignatelli.

A western Massachusetts regional office would give western Massachusetts residents a direct line and direct access to Khazei’s senate staff to help with a wide variety of constituent services, including but not limited to; help in navigating federal bureaucracy; information about federal grant programs; requests for nominations to the United States Service Academies; and scheduling appointments with the Senator or a Senate aide to find answers for their questions and concerns.
